Unit 0-1-2	<p>Unit 0 “Person 2 Person” Grammar: to be, subject pronouns, possessive adjectives, <i>this/that/these/those</i>, possessive ‘s, a/an, plural nouns. Vocabulary: the alphabet, numbers, family members, countries and nationalities Functions: Introduction and greetings, spelling out, giving personal information, describing your family, talking on the phone.</p> <p>Unit 1 “A big day” Grammar: have got, imperative, object pronouns. Vocabulary: everyday objects, adjectives of appearance and personality. Functions: describing people, giving instructions.</p> <p>Unit 2 “My place” Grammar: there is/there are, a/some/any, prepositions of place, can. Vocabulary: household objects, places in town. Functions: describing a house, talking about ability and possibility, living directions.</p>

Unit 3-4	<p>Unit 3 “Routines” Grammar: Present simple, preposition of time, like/love/enjoy/hate + ing. Vocabulary: times, dates, days of the week, months, ordinal numbers. Functions: describing routines, telling the time, saying dates, talking about preferences.</p> <p>Unit 4 “Home or away” Grammar: Present simple with wh- questions, adverbs of frequency, can/could for permission, How often...? Vocabulary: the weather and seasons, emotions. Functions: Describing your hometown, talking about frequency, asking for and giving permission, talking about the weather.</p>

Unit 5-6	<p>Unit 5 “Eat up” Grammar: countable and uncountable nouns with some/any/no, how much/ how many, a lot/ a little/ a few/ not much/ many, would like (offers, requests) Vocabulary: food and drinks, containers and prices. Functions: talking about quantities, talking about prices, buying food and drinks.</p> <p>Unit 6 “What are you doing?” Grammar: present continuous, present simple vs present continuous, too/ (not) enough. Vocabulary: clothes, phrasal verbs. Functions: describing what people are doing, asking for information, offering help, checking information.</p>

Unit 7-8	<p>Unit 7 “I remember” Grammar: past simple (to be, can). Past simple affirmative. (Regular and irregular verbs) Vocabulary: personality adjectives, school and school subjects. Functions: talking about ability in the past, talking about the past, giving and receiving news.</p> <p>Unit 8 “Childhood” Grammar: Past simple- negative and questions, Wh- words as object or subject, too much/too many. Vocabulary: school life, technology – verb collocations. Functions: talking about the past, describing photographs</p>

Unit 9- 10	<p>Unit 9 “A place called home” Grammar: comparative adjectives, possessive pronouns, superlative adjectives. Vocabulary: house and home. Functions: making comparisons, describing objects.</p> <p>Unit 10 “On the road” Grammar: going to, present continuous with future meaning. Vocabulary: travelling. Functions: making plans and arrangements, making/agreeing to/ rejecting a suggestion.</p>

Unit 11- 12	<p>Unit 11 “Look at the future” Grammar: will, adverbs of manner. Vocabulary: ecology. Functions: making predictions, giving opinions.</p> <p>Unit 12 “Have you tried?” Grammar: present perfect with ever/never, present perfect with just/already/yet, been/gone, echo questions. Vocabulary: health and fitness, sport, parts of the body. Functions: talking about personal experiences, expressing interest.</p>
